Convert VHDL to PDF


Objective: take code written in VHDL through vivado and convert it into a PDF, ready for sharing and submission.

What you'll need:

- Software:
 - o Atom.io
 - https://atom.io/
 - o An online file type converter from HTML to PDF

Procedure:

- 1. Open atom
- 2. In the toolbar, select File -> Settings
- 3. In the side menu select *Install*
- 4. Search for and install the following packages
 - a. language_markdown
 - b. markdown_writer
 - c. markdown_preview
- 5. Back in the toolbar, select File -> New File
- 6. Copy and paste your VHDL code into this file
- 7. At the top of the file tab, where it says the name of the file, right click and select *Rename*.
 - a. Add the ending .markdown making it a markdown file



8. On the first line of your code add the line ```sql

This will create syntax highlighting for sql, which is the closest option to vhdl available

- 9. Back in the toolbar, select Packages -> Markdown Preview -> Toggle Preview
- 10. Go to the preview and right click, select Save as HTML



11. Go to your online file converter and add your HTML file. Convert from HTML to PDF
